Outreach Strategy

The Town has implemented a robust strategy to provide opportunities for resident engagement. At the top level, the Town adopted a Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan which in itself included public engagement and resides on the Town Website for review. To further increase opportunities, the Connect Los Gatos program was put in place to start to create a brand and bring attention to these projects as a big picture program. Potential and developing projects are also discussed at numerous public meetings, especially the Complete Streets and Transportation Commission where commissioners provide significant input.

These efforts lead to a concept plan and early design of a project. This early design is where intense outreach to residents occurs and where input is received and reviewed. For this project, that included community meetings to review the ideas. Because the project at this stage is early in its development, there is ample room to adjust as the design progresses. This is the stage that the Shannon Road project is at now. Future progressions of the design will be shared with everyone interested as the designer gets them done.
