Meetings are held every Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. in the Town Council Chambers located in the lower level of Town Hall. The Committee consists of the Community Development Director, Building Official, and the Director of Parks and Public Works or their designee. The Fire Chief, Chief of Police, Town Attorney, and Health Officer, or their designee are also members of the DRC, but each of them only attends meetings when it is determined that the matters under consideration require attendance or when the Community Development Director requests attendance.

The Commission consists of two (2) Youth Commissioners, one (1) Arts and Culture Commissioner, one (1) Community Health and Senior Services Commissioner, one (1) Los Gatos Resident and Business Owner, one (1) Los Gatos business owner or employee, one (1) Los Gatos faith leader, one (1) Los Gatos non-profit employee, and three (3) Los Gatos residents. Each member is appointed by the Town Council, with the exception of the Arts and Culture Commissioner, Community Health and Senior Services Commissioner, and Youth Commissioners who are appointed by their respective commissions.
